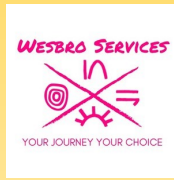

Support for anyone who is CARING for a family member or friend who has a disability, mental health condition, chronic health condition, terminal illness, or is frail aged.



We provide services that support survivors on their journey for safety and healing from sexual, domestic and family abuse.



Rosie's aims to provide friendship and unconditional acceptance to those doing it tough with a warm smile and a hot drink.



Hannah's House Young Women's Shelter offers short term supported accommodation for single young women 16-17 years. The service provides support for individuals with ongoing support and assistance with further long-term placements and supportive follow-up.



We work with clothing companies to take unsold NEW clothing to be given to people in need, whilst also protecting the environment by saving these items from landfill.



Share the Dignity is a women's charity in Australia, that works to make a real difference in the lives of those experiencing homelessness, fleeing domestic violence, or doing it tough. We distribute period products to women, girls, and anyone who menstruates who needs support. When someone is doing it tough, the last thing on their mind should be dealing with their period.

The STARH Project is an early intervention service that works alongside families and individuals offering support to stabilise and keep their housing. Clients at risk of losing their housing could be experiencing one or more of the following: tenancy issues, financial stress, debt and unforeseen financial hardship, physical and/or emotional health concerns, loss or reduction in employment, relationship or family breakdown, social isolation and/or unsafe or unstable housing.



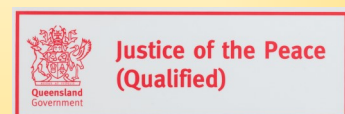
We assist the Ipswich community with free meal services to those in need. We amplify the voice of the homeless and struggling communities.

NDIS provides funding to eligible people with disability to gain more time with family and friends, greater independence, access to new skills, jobs, or volunteering in their community, and an improved quality of life. NDIS also connects anyone with disability to services in their community.



Justices of the Peace (JPs) are volunteers who undertake special responsibilities, such as signing documents that require a qualified witness and hearing certain types of court matters. Their services include witnessing and certifying routine legal documents including wills, affidavits, statutory declarations and passport applications.
