## Increase to Age Pension Eligibility Age

The age you can become an aged pensioner is changing. As of 1 July 2017 you will now be eligible when you reach the age of 65 years and 6 months, rather than the previous 65 years. This will affect everyone who was born on or after 1 July 1952. Every two years thereafter, the eligibility age will go up a further 6 months until 2023, when the minimum required age to receive the aged pension will be 67. You can submit your claim up to 13-weeks before reaching age pension age. For more information, contact Centrelink on **132 300** 

#### **Discounted Movie Tickets for Carers**

Hoyts Cinemas have announced that they are renewing their agreement to offer discounts to carers in 2017. As they have previously done, carers accompanying the person they care for to the cinema will be admitted for the price of just \$1. This offer is limited to one discounted ticket per day. To take advantage of this offer, the carer will need to produce their Carers Queensland card or any other card with **government-recognised carer identification**, such as a Healthcare Card or Centrelink Pension Card. There is a maximum of one carer-concession admission per ID card. This discount only applies when the carer is accompanying the person they are caring for to the movies. Usual rates will apply should they not be accompanying the person they care for to the movies.
