

DON'T RUSH TO FLUSH

Disposing the wrong items down toilets, sinks and drains can result in homeowners incurring expensive plumbing bills to unblock wastewater pipes on their property. Correct disposal also reduces unnecessary damage to Council's wastewater network and the environment.

How can you help?

Follow the correct disposal methods for these items.



Wet wipes

Put in the rubbish bin.



Nappies, razors, rags, cotton buds etc

Wrap and place in the garbage collection bin.



Unused medicines

Return to your local pharmacy or contact Council.



Chemicals

(paint, cleaning products)

Provide to a licensed hazardous waste contractor for proper disposal or contact council.



Cooking oil/grease

Small amounts may be placed in a sealed container and put in the rubbish bin.



Engine oil

Put in a plastic container and take to a local council landfill or transfer station.



Newspapers/plastics

Put in the recycling bin ready for council collection.



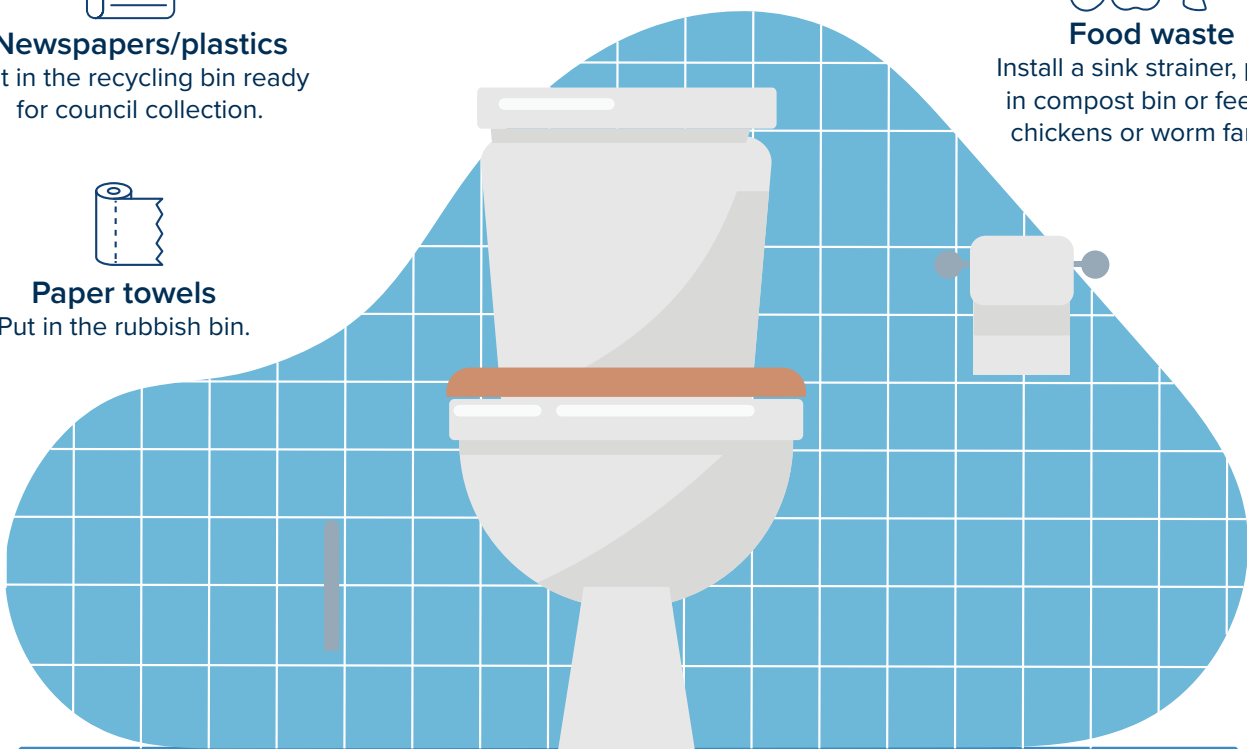
Food waste

Install a sink strainer, place in compost bin or feed to chickens or worm farms.



Paper towels

Put in the rubbish bin.
