My Health Record Opt-Out Period Extended

Following the Senate vote, the Minister for Health has announced that the opt-out period will be extended until 31 January 2019. The opt-out My Health Record website and the Helpline will be available until 31 January 2019. People can also choose to register for a My Health Record or cancel at any time. For people who do not opt out, their My Health Record will be created after 31 January. Christmas is meant to be a time of celebration, however, if times are tough it can be especially difficult. If you are going through challenging times this year, enquire at these listed services as you may be eligible for food parcel assistance.

Nexus Care - Everton Park Phone: 07 3353 7230

Offers a membership program for \$7 which entitles people to one parcel of food a month for three months.

Salvation Army: 1300 371 288

If you need help with food parcels or gifts and are going through tough times this year you may be eligible for assistance. To enquire contact your local Salvos via the Salvos Assistance Line.

St Vincent De Paul Society: 1800 846 643 May be able to offer the provision of food.

Fake Charities

During the festive season we are often seeking opportunities to give back to the community. Scammers know this and can prey on your generosity and compassion. Scammers have been known to pose as a fake charity or even impersonate well known legitimate organisations. A Scammer operating a fake charity may contact you in a number of different ways for example, you may be approached on the street or

be approached on the street or they may knock on your front door collecting money. They may also call or email you and some will set up fake websites.



If you are considering donating to charity ensure your donation is going where you are wanting it to go. You can approach your chosen charity directly to make an offer of support. Be careful of donation requests sent via email or on social media, don't click on a link provided by someone you don't know. You can also confirm if a charity is registered and their contact details on the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission (ACNC) website https://www.acnc.gov.au/for-public.

Free Council Native Plants

It has been predicted that this year's summer is going to be particularly dry and hot. Unfortunately the gardens will be taking a toll with these conditions. It is a good idea to make sure we have drought tolerant plants in our gardens. Many councils across Queensland offer free native plants to help residents establish hardy flora in their backyard and support local wildlife with providing food and shelter.

Each council has their own eligibility requirements, the number of plants you can receive, and the process on how to access and receive free plants. However, *generally* the only requirements are that: you have to be a resident of the local council and be a residential ratepayer. Make sure to check with your local council to see if they offer free native plants, however the councils below already participate in the scheme:
